 - A. Accuracy (spelling, grammar, etc.) 5%
 - B. Following directions 5%
- Extracurricular Activities-----10%
- Academics-----15%
- Industry Experience-----20%
- Zoom Interview-----20%
- Career Plans Essay-----25%
